Instructions and Information for Team Managers 2026

Dear Team Manager

Thank you for helping to manage a Team this year. We could not run the Little League without your hard work.

Little League netball is about developing skills in a sport and in having fun. The chance of winning is there to give your team a goal, but in the Little League fairness, sportsmanship and fun are more important than winning. You will have to make decisions on this basis rather than in the interests of winning a match or the league at all costs.

Contact with Players

Please set up a What's App group for your team. The Safeguarding Officer, Rhiannon Plews must be included in your What's App group. Her phone number is 07988 679794. Players must contact you if they are unavailable for any match.

Matches:

Please manage your team in accordance with the Rules for League Matches and the Fair Play Charter.

- There are three rounds each Saturday. During the season each team will play every other team once. Each week every team will have one match.
- The rounds start at 09:00, 10:00 and 11:00. Please challenge any player who arrives late. The first half hour is for warm-up and skills training. As team managers, **player development is an important part of your role**. Players and parents appreciate the effort that you put in at this time.
- Teams must be on court and ready to start at 9:30am/10:30am/11:30am. Normally one TM will umpire the match, and the other will manage the team.
- Playing positions will be decided by Team Managers fairly and on a quarter by quarter basis. Decide the positions for a quarter before the end of the previous quarter, to allow quick changeover in the three minutes allowed.
- Play your team fairly – every player should play every position during the season. Do not play any player for more than two quarters in any one position. Players may not play all four quarters while there are players available who have played fewer than three of the quarters.

Please record attendance and positions played on the record sheet. This sheet will be needed later if there are disputes about the fairness of positions allocated. The record sheet must be given to the organisers after the last league match.

Photography

Official Team Photographs will be taken on a day when you have all (or at least most) of your team present. Please ensure that any player who is noted on the team list as 'photographs refused' is excluded from any photographs (not just official team photos). Team Photographs will be available to download from the web page. For reasons of child protection, anyone wishing to take photographs must ask permission of the organisers. Tell the Organisers if anyone appears to be breaking this rule. Be alert for the use of mobile phones as cameras.

Awards

Every year the Little League awards three prizes to members of each team. The recipients must be decided by the end of the LL playing season.

- Players' Player
Towards the end of the season, the team members vote in secret for the player they think has made the biggest contribution to the team. (No player may vote for herself, but she may vote for her sister.) You will be asked to get the votes and tell the result in secret to the Organisers. In the event of a tied vote, you make the decision.
- Most Improved Player
This is awarded by the Team Managers to the player who, in their opinion, has shown most improvement in their netball skills over the year. Try not to give the award to the same girl as the Players' Player. Tell the Organisers in private whom you have selected.
- Most times chosen as Player of the Match by opposition. Record this on the Umpire's score card. You do not need to keep a tally – the organisers will do this.

Trophies for these awards are given at the Presentation Evening on 9th September. Be careful not to make these awards public before then.

Presentation Evening and Disco

This is on the evening of 11th July. This is the League's main social function, and all Team Managers should be there if possible. Because of numbers, attendance is limited to players plus one adult per player, plus LL Team Managers and Officials. No tickets will be issued. The League (and Tournament) awards will be presented. Trophies will be presented for each team to the Players' Player, Most Improved Player and most times chosen Player of the Match. Year 6 players will get a Leaver's Certificate.
